Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that:
1	The total number of section of the school shall be restricted to 10. Further increase of section shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation by laws and subject to the availability of room size of greater than 500 sq ft.
2	There is no entrance gate attached to the compound wall. The school has provided a video link (https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=wZNxivKe2E4) showing a temporary gate far away from the concrete boundary wall of the school whereas the boundary alongside the gate is not shown, thus it is not ascertained where is the gate is fixed. The concrete boundary wall closer to school is still open. The school has given an undertaking through mail (akvvidyalaya@gmail.com) that they will construct entrance gate with concrete compound wall within 15-20 days. Hence the school is directed to construct permanent entrance gates with both outer and inner boundary walls and submit the compliance within three months on SARAS portal.
3	The school has not followed the SoP of the Board for the composite lab. The composite lab is still understocked. there are wooden tables instead of stone/metal topped work stations with inbuilt utilities like water supply and piped gas supply. The safety measures like exhaust fans, fire extinguisher, first aid kit and separate exit are also not available in composite lab. Hence the school is directed to ensure safety measures, upgrade the lab as per SOP of the board and submit the compliance within 3 months on SARAS portal.
4	Ramp / lift to access upper floor are not available in the school. However the school has uploaded an undertaking that they are in process of installation of lift and will complete the installation within 15 days from the date of RC meeting. Hence the school is directed to complete the work for installation of lift and submit the compliance within 3 months on SARAS portal.
5	The school has converted regular cubicles into CWSN toilets which are too small and narrow for a wheelchair/walker to navigate. The grab bars are also incorrectly placed. Moreover the facilities are not seen in all the floors. The school shall construct separate toilets for CWSN, boys and girls on every floor with proper permanent signage as per norms of RPwD Act and guidelines issued by the Board within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
6	The school has shown separate room for indoor sports however some of the sports items are seen on the floor. The school is directed to place these items on a proper height to make it convenient to the students, upgrade the sports facilities as per SoP issued by the Board and submit the compliance within 3 months on SARAS portal.
7	As reported by RC, there is no magazines available in the library. The school is directed to make all types of books, newspaper, magazines available in the library and upgrade the library as per SoP issued by the Board and submit the compliance within 3 months on SARAS portal.
8	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Chennai within 3 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII, as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
- 2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
- 3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
- 4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., http://cbseacademic.nic.in/ & http://cbse.nic.in/ for updates.
- 5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
- 6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
- 7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
- 8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
- 9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted with in the stipulated 3 months, the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
